This award in memory of **Merioneth Moeson** is open to all BDS members competing in Exercise, Show Driving, Attelage De Tradition, Affiliated Club, Regional or National Driving Trials (Indoors/Outdoors) BDS Drives or Tree, but you must be a BDS member with a Veteran Horse/Pony/donkey 16 years old or over, Veteran Award cards are obtainable: email antonia.gallop@yahoo.com: completed cards needed by 30 September 2024; awards will be presented at the AGM, with a Special Award for the oldest turnout.

Leaf Spring Award

This award is open to all BDS members who exhibit a traditional type turnout to include light trade, on ten occasions or more in one season at a BDS Affiliated Show or BDS Area activity (Northern Ireland – four occasions, Channel Islands – three occasions.)

To take part, please obtain a Leaf Spring Award card from the BDS office, enter all details of your turnout including vehicle type, makers name and age, also your horse, pony or donkey details and details of the driver. Carry the card with you at the show/activity attended and present it to the Judge/Steward to verify the details against your turnout and sign. Not later than 30 September 2024 post your completed card on 10 events attended to the BDS office. All completed cards will receive a specially commissioned china plate presented at the AGM all those who have met the criteria above. The BDS offer Champion, Reserve Champion and Best Young Driver Rosette to BDS members.

Victoria Food Company Championship Qualifiers

This is a Victoria Food Company Open Championship qualifier. The Champions of the classes marked will qualify for the grand finals on Sunday 15 September 2024, at the Bury Farm Equestrian Village, Mill Road, Slapton, Buckinghamshire LU7 9BT.

In the event that the Champion has already qualified, then the Reserve Champion will qualify. If the reserve has also qualified, the rosette will be awarded to the Champions. ONCE QUALIFIED, THE HORSE, WHIP AND VEHICLE MAY NOT BE CHANGED.


