## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1 Entries close Wednesday 4th July 2018. Entries will be restricted in all classes, so enter in good time to be sure of acceptance.

2 Late entries will be accepted on the day at £3.00 extra for all classes, if the class is not already filled.



3 Refunds will be made on receipt of S.A.E. with vet or doctor's certificate less £6.00 administration fee. OTHERWISE REFUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE FOR RETURN OF FEES IF THE CLASS TAKES PLACE.

4 Hard hats must be worn when mounted.

5 The judge's decision is final.

6 Horses or ponies must be the minimum age of four years.

7 The Organisers accept no liability for any damage to competitors, spectators, officials or property. This is a condition of entry.

8 All challenge trophies must be returned clean by the beginning of June 2019.

9 We reserve the right to cancel classes if insufficient entries are received by the closing date, and to withhold prize money where classes are inadequately filled.

10 All rings will be marked and the classes taking part in each ring will also be marked. Competitors must be responsible for being near the ring, prior to their class starting. REFUNDS WILL NOT BE MADE IF YOU DO NOT SHOW UP ON TIME – SEE ALSO RULE 3 ABOVE.

11 All showing classes will take place in Ring 3, 4 or 5. We will try and place them in the order given in the schedule, but reserve the right to move them if many competitors are being kept waiting. We will not start any class if sufficient riders are already taking part in a similar class.

12 This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). See under Class 25 for rules.

13 All entries in the Arabian/Anglo/part-bred Arab classes must be registered in the appropriate stud-book/register of the Arab Horse Society, by the closing date of entry. Please send photocopies of registration certificates with the entries. Please go to [www.arabhorsesociety.com](http://www.arabhorsesociety.com) and click "Shows and Events" for the rules.

14 This is a qualifying show for the British Arabian Championships to be held on 8 and 9 September at Kings Equestrian Centre, [www.kingsequestrian.co.uk](http://www.kingsequestrian.co.uk). Cards are £15 each: please state horse's name, age and section when applying for a card. Cheques to be made payable to the Arab Horse Society. 16 Jumping classes will be judged under BSJA rules.

**RING 1 (starting at 9:30am)**

**All classes in this ring are sponsored by the Millwheel Tackshop at Moss End Garden Centre**

Class 1	Beginners Jumping - Fences 2' 3". Combination not to have won a jumping class.	£10.00
Class 2	Novice Jumping - Fences 2' 6". Open to all horses/ponies, riders any age.	£10.00
Class 3	Intermediate Jumping - Fences 2' 9". Open to all horses/ponies, riders any age.	£10.00
Class 4	Local Jumping - Horses or riders to live within 20 mile radius. Fences 2' 9".	£10.00
Class 5	Open Jumping for the Moss End Farm Trophy - Fences start at 3'.	£10.00

## RING 2 (starting at 9am)

- Clear Round Jumping 9am - 12 noon, followed by Class 6** £3.00  
Entries on the day - limited to 3 rounds per horse and pony. Course raised during the morning
- Class 6 Mini-Minimus Jumping** £10.00  
For riders 12 years and under; ponies 13.2hh and under; fences up to 2'. Combination not to compete in any other jumping class, except for Class 7 and 8.  
*Prize money kindly sponsored by Hilary and Harry Cannon. A trophy will be awarded.*
- Class 7 Small-size Jumping** £10.00  
Combination not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in jumping competitions. Fences 2' 3".

- Class 8 Horse and Hound Jumping** £10.00  
Jumps not to exceed 1' 6". Equines and canines to jump the same course in relay.

- Class 9 Scurry Jumping Class** £10.00  
Fastest round against the clock over a small course will win a large trophy for one year.

- Class 10 Pairs Relay Jumping – both horse/pony to jump the same course – riders of any age** £10.00

Section B CHAPS (UK) Open In Hand qualifier, any height, any type  
Section C CHAPS (UK) Open Ridden Qualifier, any height, any type

Members to apply in writing to CHAPS(UK) for appropriate qualifier card. **The CHAPS(UK) Championship Show will be held on 30<sup>th</sup> Aug–1<sup>st</sup> Sept 2018.** The following classes are CHAPS(UK) Qualifiers: 13A/B/C, 22,23,24,.
